Phonics/Reading

This week we are reviewing words with the short u vowel and the final -ump phonogram. Our story this week is called *A Cupcake Party*. The genre of this story is fantasy, but we will also be talking about poetry. Since we're talking about the final -ump sound, words we discuss will rhyme. I'm hoping with all the rhyming practice, we'll be able to have a little fun with poetry.

Math

We are now in Unit 2, where we will focus on geometry and number facts, so this will be a fun change for the students. We will be talking about shapes, their sides and working on making a shape out of other shapes. Also, please continue to work with your child on the flashcards we make in class!

Writing/Grammar

This week our focus will be on poetry. Everyone has learned so much about sentence structure, so I'm hoping learning about and writing poems will be a fun activity throughout the week. Last week we introduced singular and plural nouns, so we will also be building on that and reviewing it this week.
