Reminders

1. Green folders are to be brought into class every day. Students have been doing a good job at remembering to bring their folders back to school, but are often forgetting to bring them into class. be on the short o vowel, and consonants l and x. We are still working on decoding one syllable words, for example pot, log, rock, etc. We will be reading about Curious George during our reading hour. He's a cute little monkey with a lot of great lessons to teach, so make sure to ask what George taught them today! 😊
