Dear Parents,

I am enjoying getting to know your children. We are off to a great start! This week, we will be learning transitions and school rules, it won't be long until this habit training becomes routine for our class.

Here are just a few items of interest for you:

Children who arrive before 8:10 am must check into the before school program. This will allow me to be available to any parents that would like to visit with me.

The going home routine is very important for the safety of your child. I have asked your child to wait at the sidewalk with me until you pick them up. Your child will not be permitted to cross the parking lot without you. I have asked them to tell me good-bye when they leave to ensure that I know who has picked them up. As you can imagine, it can get hectic with all of our kids leaving at the same time. If your child has not been picked up by 3:00 pm, they will be signed into the EXCEL program. Children already staying for EXCEL will be checked in by the EXCEL staff.

Chapel is the second and fourth Mondays of each month at 8:30 a.m. Parents are welcome to attend.

Each Thursday is "Hat Day". Your child may wear a hat for \$1.00. The money collected will be donated to assist a CCS student with medical bills.

Technology will be in the computer lab with Mrs. Clover each Tuesday from 1:30 p.m.-2:00 p.m. and Library will be held each Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.

Birthdays for your child can be celebrated in class at 2:15pm. You are welcome to send in treats to celebrate. No red juice please.

Attached is the September snack calendar with a specific date for your child to bring snacks. The thought for this is to encourage healthy snacks; fresh fruit etc. and can also be used to promote the letter of the week. Please no high sugary snacks. Thank you for the crackers etc. that you have already brought in, we will use those this week. Your child's blue take home folder will be sent home each Thursday. Please return the folder on Monday's so that I may fill it up with important stuff the next week!
