Phonics/Reading

This week in phonics we will be reviewing short e spelled E and EA. We will also learn about compound words which is two words in one, snowflake, mailbox, football... This week we will read Little Rabbit's Tale. This is a folktale, so it's a make-believe story that is meant to teach the kids a lesson. The story relates to Chicken Little, so the kids are all familiar! 😊

Grammar/Writing

This week we are learning about prepositions and prepositional phrases. Example: *The chair is under the desk.* The words *under the desk* tell where the chair is, which is a prepositional phrase. This is a very new concept for the kids, so please let me know if they need any extra help. We will also discuss compound words. In writing we've been talking about personal narratives and writing friendly notes and letters. If your child brings home any writing this week, please encourage them to use friendly and or loving words when writing.

Math

In math we are wrapping up our unit on different strategies for adding and subtracting whole numbers. Again, if you notice your child having any troubles in math, please let me know! Things are getting harder, so I don't want them to miss out on important things!
