Phonics/Reading

This week in phonics we will learn about r-Controlled vowels er, ir, ur. This week we will read **Amazing Animals**. This is an informational text, so it will give us facts about animals. We will also discuss details and conclusions. Sometimes the author of a text doesn't give all the details. Readers must use text evidence from words and pictures to make a smart guess about what the author doesn't tell. We will also be reading The Ugly Duckling, which is a folktale that teaches us how special things come in all sorts of forms. The text talks about body parts that help animals do amazing things, so feel free to talk about animals that have special "powers" at home! 😊

Grammar/Writing

This week we are learning about the pronouns **I** and **Me**. Example: **I see polar bears. My mom hugs me. Dad hugs me, too.** In writing, we will be discussing what details help make great story sentences. We will work on brainstorming with partners and writing details that support the topic and conclusion.

Math

In Unit 4 we will work on sorting objects and discussing what attributes and rules contribute to the placement of them. We will also continue to work on addition and subtraction of numbers up to 20, telling time, and work a little on coins. This week we will work on collecting and representing data, taking surveys, and putting things into categories.
