## Phonics/Reading

This week in phonics we will learn about vowel digraph /oo/. This week we will read **Whistle for Willie**. This story is realistic fiction, so it's something that could happen in real life. We will also discuss cause and effect, one story event causes another event to happen, and figurative language. Figurative Language is when the author uses words to help the reader picture things in the story. We will also be reading Pet Poems later in the week. It is several poems about different pets and how we love them. Both texts talk about pets, so discussing ways we can take of our pets at home would be great to discuss this week! 😊

## Grammar/Writing

This week we are learning about the possessive pronouns, **my, your, his, and her**. These are pronouns that show ownership. In writing, we will work on and discuss writing a summary. A summary tells only the important parts of a story. We will also work on using time and order to organize our thoughts and findings.

## Math

We will be wrapping up Unit 4 this week. In this unit we worked on sorting objects and discussing what attributes and rules contribute to the placement of them. We also worked on addition and subtraction of numbers up to 20 and telling time. This week we will finish collecting and representing data, taking surveys, and putting things into categories. At the end of the week we will take a test over unit 4, so if you notice your child having troubles in any areas, please let me know.
