Phonics/Reading

This week in phonics we will learn about the long i vowel spelled igh, y, and ie. Our spelling words this week will also have long i spelled those three ways, so hopefully that will help students master the sound. This week we will read "The Kite" from Days With Frog and Toad. This story genre is fantasy, so it's a story that could not happen in real life. We will also be reading Measuring Weather which is an informational text, and will teach us about different ways to measure the weather. Both stories are about weather, but we will be talking about how a change in the weather can change your day. This is a familiar experience when living in Idaho, so that will be a fun topic of conversation for home this week! 😊

Grammar/Writing

This week we are learning about adjectives, which are describing words. In writing, we will continue to work on opinion writing and also start to talk about using elaboration when writing.

Math

We finished up Unit 5 and are starting on Unit 6 this week! In this unit, we will focus on combinations of ten, combinations of numbers, and addition and subtraction. We will continue to work on flashcards and number facts in class, and please encourage your child to work on them at home too!
